## Directions to Meet

**From I-71** Exit at Red Bank Rd., proceed east on Red Bank Rd. approx. 2 miles. Turn left onto US 50 East (Columbia Parkway/Wooster Pike) at sixth traffic signal. Proceed east on US 50 through Fairfax and Mariemont. Turn left onto Pocahontas at the fourth traffic light (Mariemont Branch Library on the NE Corner).

**From Ronald Reagan Cross Country Highway East** Exit at Montgomery Rd. South, the east terminus of RR Hwy. Proceed south on Montgomery Road. Turn left onto Miami Rd. at the blinking yellow traffic signal (third signal). Proceed south on Miami Rd. through Madeira to Miami Rd. terminus in the center of Mariemont. Proceed around traffic circle, in the village square, turning east on US 50. Turn left onto Pocahontas at the first traffic signal (Mariemont Branch Library on the NE Corner)

## Kindergarten through Second Grade Start at 8:30AM

Order of Running Events – 50M, 75M, 100M, 200M, 400M Relay. **Girls run first**

*Note: This order of events is different than the standard CYO meet format for this age group.*

Field Events – Long Jump, Softball Throw. Boys do field events first.

Ribbons will be awarded to all participants in each heat of every event

**Each field event participant must have a sticker with their name, grade & school.**

## Third and Fourth Grade Start at 11:30AM

Order of Running Events – 800M Relay, 50M, 75M, 100M, 200M, 400M, 400M Relay. **Girls run first**

*Note: This order of events is different than the standard CYO meet format for this age group*

Field Events – Long Jump, High Jump, Softball Throw, Shot Put. Boys do field events first.

Ribbons will be awarded to all participants in each heat of every event

**Each field event participant must have a sticker with their name, grade & school.**

## Fifth and Sixth Grade Start at 2:30PM

Order of Running Events - 800M Relay, 75M, 400M Relay, 400M, 100M, 800M, 75M

Finals, 200M, 1600M Relay. **Girls Run First**

**NO TIMING OF INDIVIDUAL RUNNERS AT THIS MEET. NO PRE-REGISTRATION**

There will be (3) three “All-Star” heats at the beginning of the 75M, 100M, 200M and 400M events.

No more than one participant per school in the three “Elite” heats unless lanes are open 5 minutes before the start of the event.

Spots in the first three “Elite” heats will be based on arrival in the staging area after first call.

Meet Director reserves the right to increase or decrease number of “Elite” heats.

There will be (1) “Elite” heat at the beginning of the 800M event.

Field Events – Long Jump, High Jump, Shot Put, Discus.

Top 3 in each “Elite” running heat and top 3 overall in each field event will receive medals.

Top 3 teams in the 1600m relay will receive trophies.

All other finishers will receive ribbons based on their finish in their respective heat / flight.

**Each field event participant must have a sticker with their name, grade & school.**

## Meet Rules

Each participant may compete in three (3) events. Coaches should register and report the number of participants to the press box prior to each session. There is a **\$3.00** entry fee per participant. Checks should be made payable to **Mariemont Recreation Association**. No spikes.
